
Dear Parents and Families,

Australian Maths Competition

In August, 190,000 Australian students took part in the Australian Mathematics Competition. Congratulations to the 43 Year 4, 5 and 6 Goollelal students who chose to take part this year. Of those who participated, 17 were awarded a certificate of Proficiency and 11 achieved a Credit. Congratulations to Charli F, Phoebe J, Rama P, Mathys E, Chris H, Jarvis K, Daniel N and Xander C for being awarded a Distinction. With a fabulous score of 95, congratulations to Xander C for achieving the Best in School award.









Curriculum News-Times Tables

The foundations for solving multiplication algorithms (a step by step solution to a maths problem) begins in our early years when we teach students to make sets and groups of concrete materials. It is important that children comprehend what multiplication means before we teach them times tables by rote, or parrot fashion. For example, we don't simply say, "3 times 4 equals 12," we show how that works by showing how 3 groups of 4 objects makes 12 objects. This is an important stepping stone as young children often mix up 3 + 4 with 3 x 4 if they don't have an underlying understanding of the different maths operations. Another important step is for students to understand how they can reach a multiplication answer by skip counting. For example, they can find the product of 4 x 6 by skip counting by fours a total of 6 times e.g. 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24. After a thorough understanding of multiplication has been established, students can start working on memorisation and quick recall of multiplication facts by learning the times tables. This begins in Year 3 with automatic recall of the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables. In Year 4, we practice multiplication facts up to 10 x 10 and beyond.
