

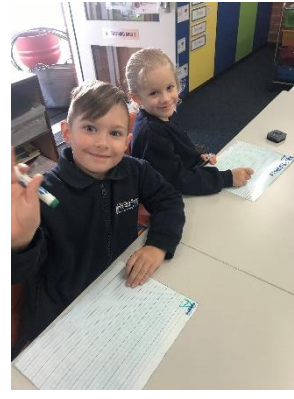

Dear Parents and Carers,

On Monday the 22nd of June the WA Premier announced that as of Saturday the 27th of June, we will be moving into Phase 4 of Australia's Roadmap for easing restrictions. As we are soon approaching school holidays, we will continue with the current operations until Friday the 3rd of July and I will send out an update early next term to outline any changes.

I continue to be amazed at the independence shown by all our students as they come into school in the morning. All the teachers have commented on how quickly their classes are getting into the classroom and settling down to work each morning.



To celebrate, we will be holding two special events next week. On Wednesday the 1st of July, we will be holding an assembly to for students and teachers only. At the assembly, teachers will be awarding Honour Certificates to some students who have gone above and beyond in class and in the playground this term. As parents and carers cannot attend, we will be making a video of the assembly to put on CONNECT and the school Facebook page.

On Friday the 3rd of July, we will be having a fun, dress up day to celebrate the end of a great term and to acknowledge frontline workers. The children and staff may dress up as a checkout operator, nurse, teacher, tradie, doctor or any of the many workers who helped to keep us going during Phase 1.

Current Operations

Teacher/Parent Meetings must be pre-arranged	Parents and carers can email their child's classroom teacher or school staff, or call 6207 2100, to pre- arrange a face to face meeting time.
Visiting the Office	Visitors inside the front office will be limited to no more than 2 adults at a time.
Morning Drop Off and Afternoon Pick Up	To maintain social distancing, we ask that parents continue to drop off/meet children at the school perimeter or use the Kiss and Drive <u>if possible</u> . If, for any reason, you do need to enter the school, please <u>do not enter the classrooms</u> . Please be mindful of parking around the school as rangers have been in attendance and issued fines for illegal parking. Children entering the school grounds before 8.30am will be asked to sit quietly on the benches outside classrooms until their classroom is opened.
Kiss and Drive- Staff in attendance on Kindy days	We have extended the use of the Kiss and Drive facility to <u>all parents</u> . Please follow these important safety rules: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students can <u>only</u> be dropped off and picked up from the front 2 cars. • Please do not allow children to exit the car until you reach the front 2 cars. • Children must exit the car on the passenger side (kerb side). • Please do not overtake cars in the Kiss n Drive. • 5k speed limit in the Kiss n Drive. • Please do not exit your car unless your child has trouble unbuckling/buckling seatbelts. If you need to get out to do this, please do so quickly to avoid holding up traffic. A full set of guidelines for the Kiss and Drive has been sent to all parents/carers on CONNECT
Picking children up during the day	Parents and carers who need to pick their child up during the school day should notify the office by emailing Goollelal.PS@education.wa.edu.au or phoning 6207 2100. Parents and carers may come to the office to wait for your child (maximum of 2 visitors in the office foyer).
Attendance	Attendance is now back to normal. If your child becomes sick during the day we will err on the side of caution and call parents or carers to collect them from the school office. If your child is sick before school, please notify us as usual through the Skoolbag app or by emailing Goollelal.PS@education.wa.edu.au As the children have missed a significant amount of school time this year, we ask that parents and carers reconsider vacations or non-essential days off in school times.
Canteen	Our canteen is open on Wednesdays for lunches only. All orders must be done online using [https://quickcliq.com.au/] No cash will be accepted.
Assemblies	Due to social distancing measures and Assembly Area renovations, assemblies will not be held until further notice.
Choir	Choir will not operate until further notice.
P&C and Board Meetings	Face to face meetings can resume with physical distancing requirements.
