To join, all it takes is a silver or gold coin donation!

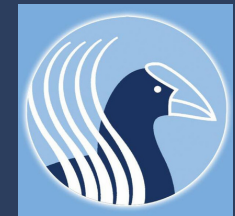
2. Volunteer
