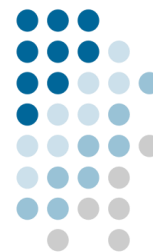




## GOOLLELAL PRIMARY SCHOOL BOARD MEETING MINUTES

<p><b><u>2. Minutes of previous meeting</u></b></p>	<p>Minutes of Meeting held on 8 September 2022</p>	<p>The minutes of the last meeting were endorsed by Chris Quelch and seconded by Pat Kiddey. The minutes were signed off by the Principal and Board Chair.</p>
<p><b><u>3. Budget Update</u></b></p>	<p>One line budget statement Comparative Budget</p>	<p>The Principal discussed the one line budget and drew attention to the variance of \$92 394. This is a healthy variance that will go down a small amount to accommodate for projects that have been undertaken including the new flag poles, classroom painting and nature playground.</p>

School Development Days 2023</u></b></p>	<p>Proposed School Development Days for 2023</p>	<p>The Board supported the scheduled school development days for 2023 which were planned in line with department policy and in consultation with other local schools.</p> <p>Early close for interviews proposed for 28 March 2023.</p>
<p><b><u>5. Student Outcome Data</u></b></p>		<p>Review of School's Professional Learning Journey. Focus on Collective Teacher Efficacy.</p> <p>NAPLAN data explained. Noted that the impact of whole school approaches will not be evident for a few years.</p> <p>PLD, Brightpath and Early Birds data reviewed. Progress being made across the programs.</p>



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<b><u>6. Homework Policy</u></b>	Homework Policy 2018	Current homework guidelines a good framework but not in line with consistent teaching approach. Move to create a homework policy that is more explicit and consistent for 2023. Homework is for the consolidation of learning and the establishing good habits.
<b><u>7. Board Membership</u></b>		Principal moves that Pat Kiddey be re-appointed as Community Member for 2023. Seconded by Chris Quelch.  Kelly Egan re-elected unopposed as the staff representative for another three years.
<b><u>8. General Business</u></b>		Training options for the board chair will be investigated for 2023.  Board Meeting to be tentatively booked for Wednesday 15 February 2023.  Class Structures for 2023 still being finalised.
