



**Principal's Report to the P&C

Edu Dance

Our children have started rehearsing for this year's Edu-Dance concert, which will be held on Thursday 7 December. The start time will be 5:30 pm, aiming to avoid the worst of the summer heat while still ensuring that there is enough light for the show to go ahead.

For 2023, Edu Dance has advised that they no longer offer a kindergarten performance. Kindergarten students are welcome to attend the concert as spectators. Our kindy class will perform a small Christmas dance for parents during a school day near the end of year.

2024 school structure
