When using school technology and Department of Education online services, students are expected to:

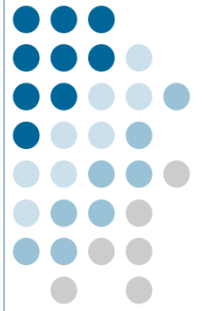
- Keep their password private and not share with other students.
